

GRT Survival Checklist for Las Cruces Small Businesses – 2025 Edition

- Deadlines: File Gross Receipts Tax (GRT) by the 25th of each month for the prior month's receipts (e.g., Jan 2025 due Feb 25, 2025). Late fees start at \$5 or 2% of tax due, whichever's greater—per NM Taxation & Revenue Dept (TRD).
- Know Your Rate: Las Cruces GRT ~8.3125%
 (2024)—check annual updates at <u>tax.newmexico.gov/rates</u> as rates vary by location (e.g., lower outside city limits).
- Track It Right: Record receipts and bank statements monthly—use a "2025 GRT" folder or QuickBooks category for audits (3-year TRD window).
- Las Cruces Twist: Local rate ~8.3125% (2024, per TRD)—expect a slight bump in 2025; confirm via TRD's rate table in Jan.
- Action: Email receipts to christine@notthetaxlady.com—l'll file it right and keep penalties off your back.
- Why: Saves you cash (like \$500 penalties!), keeps compliance tight, and frees you to grow your biz.
